

Project Management - the basics

Who is it for?

This short two day programme is for anyone involved in looking to deliver projects on time, within budget through the effective management of people.

Overview

Increasingly organisations need to assemble project teams quickly to manage the constantly changing customer and market demands and a cohesive and motivated project team is essential if projects are to achieve their objectives. The effective project manager is therefore required to balance their time between managing the task, coaching individuals, and leading the team. These three needs are constantly interacting upon each other. This programme is designed to provide an intensive introduction to the world of people management, focusing on achieving results with and through people. The programme is highly practical - the return on investment starts the minute the participant re-enters their working environment.

Workshop Objectives

- Identify the essential stages in managing a project.
- Define the scope and the objectives of a project.
- Communicate clear, concise action plans with stakeholders.
- Identify the key elements of a project plan and apply a range of tools to plan, control and conclude a project.
- Practice the skills and attitudes to effectively lead and monitor a project.

Investment
